- Areas: Bolgrad (Odessa region), Beregovo (Tranthcarpathia), Gerza (Chernivtsi region)
- Enclaves: Roma in Transcarpathia
- «Joint Stocks»: mixed ethnic origin with tangible Ukrainian and Russkiye components – most regions of the North, of the West, of the South, of the Center, of the East, of the Crimea

# EDUCATION (IN ACCORDANCE WITH ETHNIC LANGUAGES)

Schools: Ukrainian – 15 020; Russian– 581; Romanian – 75; Hungarian – 71; Polish – 5; Mold. – 3; several languages – 619)

**Pupils:** total of 3,8 mio (3,7 mio // 23 000)

Languages: Ukrainian- 3 400 000; Russian - 356 000; Romanian - 16 000; Hungarian - 16 000; Moldavian - 3 000; Polish - 2 000; English - 379; Slovakian - 145; Bulgarian - 61.

Education of educators for national minorities: Russian (in many universities), Hungarian (Uzhgorod), Romanian (Chernivtsi); Foreign languages: departments in most universities.
